

SERVICE LEARNING IN KENYA – SLIK

For High School Sophomores, Juniors and Seniors



What to Expect:

Experienced leadership. SLIK founder and trip leader Fred Roberts lived in Kenya from 1986 to 1999 and owns the facility where the students stay while in Kenya. Mr. Roberts has been offering this trip since 2005 and is close friends with the teachers and headmasters that will be working with the Americans.

Volunteer teaching. Serve as a volunteer teacher at a public primary school near the town of Naro Moru. Responsibilities include lesson planning, classroom teaching, and assisting with extra curricular activities with the Kenyan students.

Community Service. Two days of actively assisting in a project to serve the community. This may include painting a classroom or mixing cement for new classroom floors. Be prepared for physical labor!

Cultural interaction. Along with interacting with Kenyan teachers and students, the Americans will visit the homes of Kenyans living in a rural area and gain a first hand understanding of their lifestyle. Students will also meet with elders who were part of Kenya's struggle for independence in the 1950s.

Learning. Most evening the students will have a variety of classes related to Kenya's history, natural history, and national language, Kiswahili.

Wildlife safari. A three-day safari to one of Kenya's game reserves where the group will camp and see the wildlife for which this area is famous.

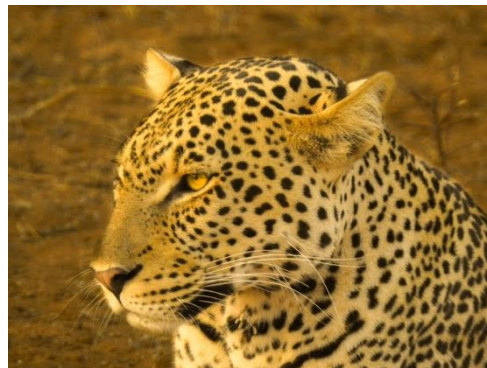
Experiential education. A day will be spent with leadership and team building activities on the high and low challenge course at Batian's View. Kenyan high school students may also be a part of this activity.

Mt. Kenya hike. A four-day trek on Mt. Kenya going from the dense forest zone to the alpine area above 15,000'. Depending on weather and other factors summiting Pt. Lenana at 16,355' will be attempted.

Dates: Depart home on June 15 – Return on July 10, 2021.

Tuition: \$4,300.00 To reserve a space a non-refundable deposit of \$500.00 is required no later than March 20, 2021. Group size is limited to 16. Travel plans will be made soon after this date.

Travel to/from Kenya: Arrangements are made for all students to travel together, meeting at a major airline hub in the US.
